You must indicate which position you would like to stand for and ensure that your form is signed by two CCA Members (for membership status queries please call the CCA on 0330 056 8144).

Please email us your CV at the same time that you send in your nomination form to **cca@conservatives.com**. This will be posted in the secure area of our website for CCA Members to consider. If you do not send us an electronic CV at this time we regret that you may not be able to include one at a later date. Please keep your CV to **one side of A4 paper maximum** and send it to us in Word or PDF format.

You must sign the nomination form and send it to Daniel Chapman, the Secretary to the CCA Board by: **Noon on Friday 6th February 2026**.

The CCA election will be administered by email and voting will take place via a website. Full instructions on this process will be emailed in advance. CVs of the nominated candidates will be available to view in the secure area of our website - www.conservativecouncillors.com.

Owing to some councils' email filter settings, we would prefer to send the ballot email to a personal email address, such as Hotmail or gmail, to ensure receipt of the ballot email. Please inform us of your personal email address by 6th February 2026. Remember to check your junk email folder for your voting email. Postal ballots will be issued to those who do not have an email address listed on our database.

Ballot papers will be issued no later than 13th February 2026. Voting will close at noon on 27th February 2026.
